Qualification Description

This qualification reflects the role of individuals working as developing and emerging leaders and managers in a range of enterprise and industry contexts. In addition to being responsible for their own performance, individuals at this level provide leadership, guidance and support to others. They may also have some responsibility for organising and monitoring the output of their team. They apply solutions to a defined range of predictable and unpredictable problems, and analyse and evaluate information from a variety of sources.

Duration

This course will be delivered over 12 workshop days fortnightly or in a combination suitable to the group. The workshops are followed by time allowed to complete the assessment at the workplace. Allow 12 months to complete the course.



Course Delivery & Assessment

The course will be delivered in 2 phases as follows:

<u>Phase 1</u> – Knowledge & Skill building workshops over 12 days covering all the units of competencies (delivered either as 1 day per week or 1 day per fortnight).

<u>Phase 2</u> – 1:1 Coaching & Mentoring sessions provided over a 12-month period to assist participants complete the workplace project-based assignment to acquire the qualification.

The course is delivered in the following manner in the sequence above:

- Half-day course information and assessment session delivered about 1-2 weeks prior to the commencement of the course;
- One-on-one enrolment interviews with each participant to determine their entry skills and competencies and their capacity to undertake a 12-month Accredited qualification.
- Face-to-face knowledge workshops (theory), 1-day in duration for each unit, 2 weeks apart delivered by qualified trainers and assessors from Infinity Training Australia;
- The sequence of delivery will depend upon the group requirements and will be decided by key stakeholders.
- One to one assessment interviews will be conducted with each person at the end of each unit of competency to plan and set up the assessment;
- Ongoing 1 to 2 hour individual workplace learning and assessment mentoring sessions at the workplace until completion of course;
- Self-paced assessment (with ongoing support by assessor)

Assessment Methods

Assignments, activities and projects are based on demonstration of competency in the required performance criteria for each unit. On successful completion of each unit students are awarded a Competency Achieved (CA) result and grade. Participants will be advised of the assessment requirements at the beginning of each unit. Assessment will usually commence in the session following delivery. As this is a competency based program, assessment continues throughout the program until the participant either achieves competency in the assessment tasks or a further training need is identified and addressed. In order to achieve the qualification BSB40520 Certificate IV in Leadership & Management, participants must be Competent in all 12 units of competency.

The assessment process may include:

- Written Questions
- Observation
- Case studies
- Projects (simulation/Real Work)
- Assignments



- Presentations
- Written examinations
- Integrated assessment of some units may occur
