## **BSB50820 Diploma of Project Management**

### **Qualification Description**

This qualification reflects the role of individuals who apply project management skills and knowledge in a variety of contexts, across a number of industry sectors. The job roles that relate to this qualification may include Project Manager and Project Team Leader. Individuals in these roles have project leadership and management roles and are responsible for achieving project objectives. They possess a sound theoretical knowledge base and use a range of specialised, technical and managerial competencies to initiate, plan, execute and evaluate their own work and/or the work of others.

### **Overview**

Diploma of Project Management is a competency-based award at Australia Qualifications Framework (AQF) Level 5. Competencies at the Diploma level describe the functions of a project manager who manages the work of project team members. Twelve units of competency from the National Competency Standards for Project Management are required for the qualification. These units of competency are in line with the Project Management Body of Knowledge (PMBOK) adopted by the Australian Institute of Project Management.

### **Who Should Attend?**

This course is designed for project managers (or those who plan to pursue project management as their profession) who wish to reinforce the project management skills they have acquired on the job and obtain formal recognition. The course is also suitable for project team members who are expecting to move into positions as project managers.

### **Pre-requisites**

There are no formal pre-requisites for undertaking the course. However, course participants are expected to have levels of language, literacy and numeracy usually required of project managers and to be in a position to assemble the required portfolio of evidence.

### **Packaging Rules**

**Total number of units = 12**

**8 core units** plus

**4 elective units**, which must be relevant to the work environment and the qualification.

## Duration

Allow 12 months to complete the qualification for those with limited prior knowledge or experience in project management.

## Delivery Model

The course will be delivered in 2 phases as follows:

**Phase 1** – Knowledge & Skill building workshops over 10-12 days covering all the project management units of competencies – delivered over a period of time (eg 1 day per week or 1 day per fortnight).

**Phase 2** – 1:1 Coaching & Mentoring sessions provided over a 12-month period to assist participants complete the workplace project-based assignment to acquire the qualification.

## Course Delivery & Assessment

The course is delivered in the following manner in the sequence above:

- 2-hour course information and assessment session delivered about 1-2 weeks prior to the commencement of the course
- Face-to-face knowledge workshops for each unit, total of 10-12 days;
- One to one assessment interviews will be conducted with each person at the end of the workshop phase to plan and set up the assessment
- Ongoing 1 to 2-hour individual workplace learning and assessment mentoring sessions at the workplace until completion of course.

- Self-paced assessment (with ongoing support by assessor)

## Assessment Methods

Assignments, activities and projects are based on demonstration of competency for each unit. Assessment will usually commence in the session following delivery. As this is a competency based program, assessment continues throughout the program until the participant either achieves competency in the assessment tasks or a further training need is identified and addressed. In order to achieve the qualification BSB50820 Diploma of Project Management, participants must be Competent in all 12 units of competency.

The assessment process may include a combination of some of the below:

- Written Questions & Case study analysis
- Observation
- Projects (simulation/Real Work)
- Assignments
- Presentations
- Integrated assessment of some units may occur
